INVITATION FOR BIDS

- 1. The EU-GIZ ACSE PROJECT MANAGEMENT UNIT/ Ministry of Environment, Climate Change, Disaster Management and Meteorology (MECDM), hereinafter called the "Employer", invites sealed Tenders from eligible and qualified Tenderers for the Construction of Solar PV and Diesel Power Hybrid Power System at Selwyn College, 50+ kilometers, Maravovo, West Guadalcanal (by road). Full Description of the Works Requirement is in the Tender documents.
- 2. Tender Number: CTB C 87/18 and Project Name: Construction of Solar PV and Diesel Power Hybrid Power System at Selwyn College
- 3. In addition to the eligibility requirements detailed in the Tender document, to qualify for Award of the Contract, Tenderers shall meet the following **Minimum Qualifications**:
 - (a) experience in the construction of at least two (2) successfully completed works of a nature and complexity similar to the Works in the last five years;
 - (b) able to provide or acquire (by own, lease, hire, etc.) the essential equipment required to complete the works;
 - (c) a Construction Manager with three years' experience in works of similar nature and volume; and
 - (d) liquid assets and/or credit facilities, net of other contractual commitments and exclusive of any advance payments which may be made under the Contract, of no less than fifty per cent (50%) of the total tender price
 - (e) be in possession of a Solomon Islands electrical contractor's license (either the head contractor, or a sub-contractor within the bidder's team must have this)
- 4. Tendering will be conducted through the **SIG Standard Competitive Tendering Procedures**, and is open to all Eligible Tenderers as defined in the Tender Documents.
